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Description of the Case Study

Main difficulties in chemistry learning at school: *Students are unwilling to learn*

Main difficulties in chemistry teaching at school: *Poor motivation which is largely the result of the government policy in education and the situation in the country*

Identification of the main reasons why students do not choose to continue learning scientific subjects and chemistry in particular: *Lack of material base and necessary equipment which encumbers the study process. No vocational opportunities with chemistry as most of the factories in the chemical industry are closed.*

Identification of strategies to rise the number of students choosing to learn scientific subjects in higher education: *Young people should be offered clearly defined prospects for self realization and professional progress*

Description of initiatives known in the field of promoting lifelong learning: *I don't know about such of initiatives*

Involvement in initiatives in the field of promoting lifelong learning: *There isn't*
